

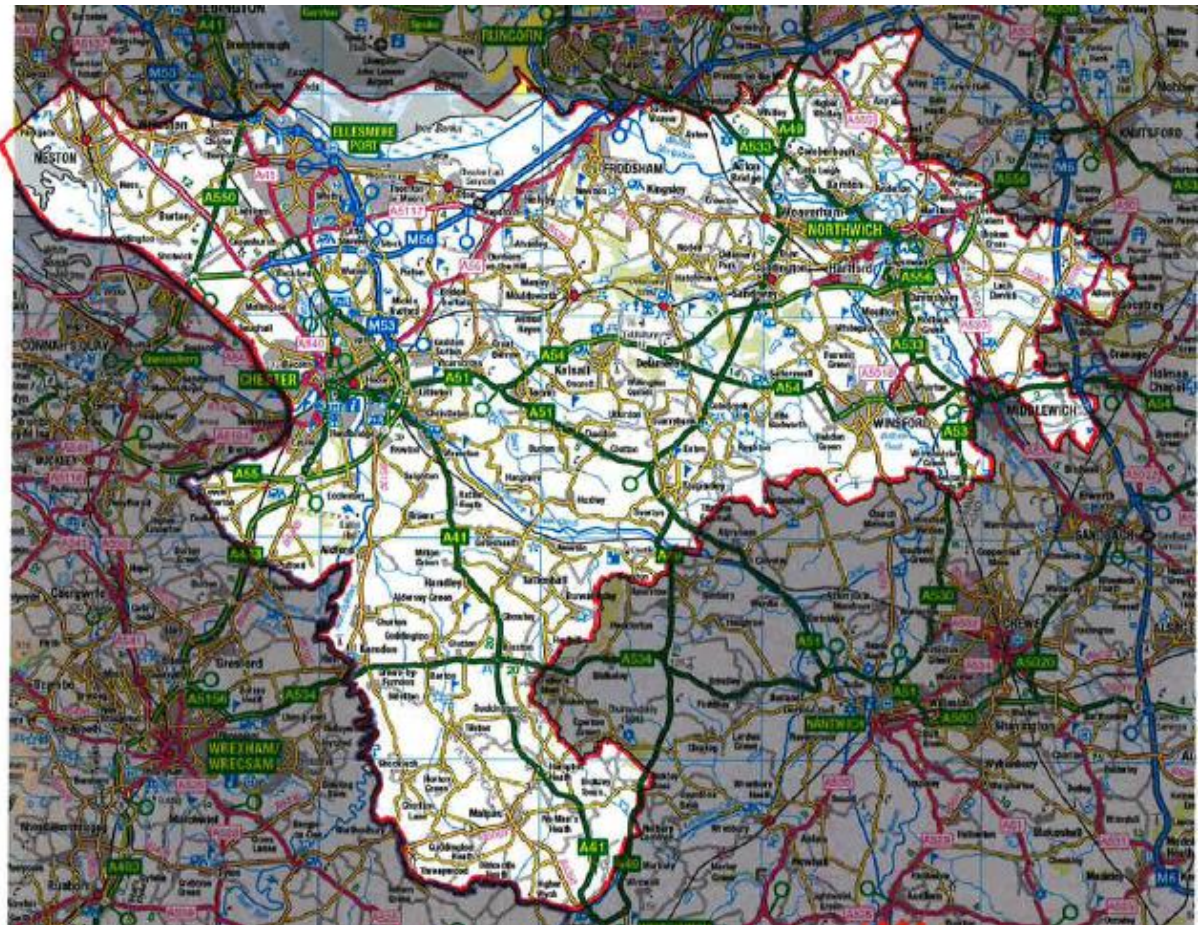
Cheshire West and Chester

Public Spaces Protection Orders

Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council in exercise of the power under section 59 of the Anti-Social Behaviour Crime and Policing Act 2014 (“the Act”) being satisfied that the conditions set out in section 59 of the Act have been met make the following Orders:

Subject to specific exemptions and defences, Persons within the area shown below shall:

1. Not allow dogs to enter the following areas:
 - A Fully Enclosed Children’s Play Areas which contains Play Equipment
 - A Fully or Partially enclosed Multi Use Games Areas (MUGAs)
 - A Tennis Court
2. If in charge of a dog, have with them the means to pick up dog faeces
3. At the request of an authorised officer place the dog on a lead with a maximum length of 2m and keep it on that lead as directed to do so by the authorised officer. The 2m length can be a fixed, clipped or locked length
4. Not walk more than 6 dogs at any one time, whether on behalf of a business or otherwise
5. Not smoke within a Fully Enclosed Children’s Play Areas which contains Play Equipment



This Order will Commence on 20th October 2018 for a Period of 3 years. Any person who fails to comply with the requirements of the Order is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding £1000 or a fixed penalty notice of a maximum £100.
