Report from the Chairman:

Welcome to Spring and the progression into summer. There will be many new things popping up in Waverton soon!

The planters sited through the Village to coincide with the Platinum Jubilee will be installed soon, and volunteers living near are sought to aid in topping up their reservoir tank.

Other things springing up will be a row of plastic bollards in the verge on the corner of Guy Lane and Millway, then down Millway and the corner with Ringway, all in an effort to stop vehicles ruining the grass verges particularly in the wet weather as they stop to visit the shops.

The Village Green next to the canal will move to be the responsibility of the Parish Council over the next few months, transferring from the Trust that has owned and looked after it for many years. We thank John Kendall and Ed Walley for the time and effort over many years which they have devoted to the upkeep of the site for the benefit of Wavertonians and many visitors besides.

The Village Hall will move back into direct management of the Parish Council from May as the Charitable Trust that has managed it for many years has decided to step down. We thank them for the work they have given to care, sustain and invest in the Hall and latterly to bring many updates to the fabric of the building, and recently to help train us in all the things necessary to take over the running of the Hall. Our Cleaning staff, Carmel and Stephen, will continue and we ask all to show us forbearance as we gradually take over the running of the Hall.

The Platinum Jubilee then the Fun Run and Fete and, of course, good weather – it's all shaping up for a great summer!

Extension to the Village Churchyard at St Peter's Church

All residents living in Waverton are eligible to be buried in the Churchyard. The current area is nearing its capacity and the Grosvenor Estate has given some land to extend it. The Parish Council has contributed financially to help with its development for the Village.

The pictures show the new area looking southeast towards Beeston Castle and back towards old Waverton. Wildflowers will soon be sown with the new trees in the extension. The churchyard is maintained by volunteers from St Peters and the Village, and more help is always welcome.






Why not come along, bring your dog and enter the owner/dog agility competitions?
