A41 A41 Speed Camera/Speed Reduction ePetition

Rowton Parish Councillor, Peter Thomas, has been instrumental in organising this ePetition asking CWaC to lower the speed limit from 40mph to 30mph from The Cheshire Cat pub in Christleton to the junction of Quarry Lane, Waverton on the A41. The ePetition also calls for the installation of average speed cameras from the A55 Christleton junction to Quarry Lane junction, Waverton. This successful ePetition is now closed and Cllr Thomas is due to meet with officers from CWaC in October to make further representations. We will keep you informed of developments.



Moor Lane Drainage Problems

Moor Lane residents will have once again experienced the distress and inconvenience of the sewer overflowing. After the Parish Council approached both CWaC Environmental Health and United Utilities a survey of the sewer has been completed and blockages and defects have been identified. United Utilities have confirmed that they will be undertaking a cleaning programme which will hopefully fix the problem. The Parish Council will continue to monitor the situation.
