There is no commitment on the resident to take up the CityFibre offer after the registration of interest phase has been completed. Registering your interest would be beneficial to the community as a whole.

#### Costs

Nothing to pay for initial installation - CityFibre bear the costs of the physical installation.

Residents will not receive any bills from CityFibre. Costs will only be incurred after the household has signed up to a chosen ISP. Note ISP broadband contract lengths may vary and the contract chosen is personal matter.

#### When

This is largely dependent on how quickly the count of registrations of intent reach "sweet spot" allowing CityFibre to enter the planning stage for the installation across all 4 villages.

The aim will be to get the initial "registration of intent" phase completed as quickly as possible and if all goes according to plan CityFibre hope to start installation of the network late 2022 or early 2023. *Obviously, estimates are subject the usual caveats.* 

#### Where

Four villages: Christleton Littleton Rowton Waverton All households and businesses within all the four villages.

#### Speeds to offered in the Four Villages

Guaranteed up to 1 GB (Gigabyte) to every Post Code. ISPs offerings based on speed & tariffs.

## The quicker we, as a community, register in sufficient numbers, the sooner FTTP Fibre to the Premises (Ultrafast) Broadband installation will be planned and undertaken by CityFibre.
